Welcome! Kent ISD is proud to present “Spanish for Conferences”. This program will teach you basic information to use during your parent-teacher conferences. The written script will help you to follow along with the audio program.

The Conference Script will teach you how to communicate your name and position, your student’s grade and number of absences, your satisfaction or concern with your student’s work, and your contact information.

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Spanish Introduction and Pronunciation Tips

A few things to know:

- Spanish is gender specific- most words end in an ‘o’ if they are masculine and an ‘a’ if they are feminine.
- Not all dialects of Spanish are the same, but this script will convey the important information to nearly everyone.
- Don’t worry about being perfect – your efforts to speak Spanish will be greatly appreciated by your student and by their parents/families.

Grades and Absences:

- Let’s review the letters A, B, C, D, and E
 - A = ahh
 - B = bay
 - C = say
 - D = day
 - E = long “a”
 - + = plus
 - - = menos
- Let’s review the numbers 0 – 10
 - 1 = uno 1st = primero
 - 2 = dos 2nd = segundo
 - 3 = tres 3rd = tercero
 - 4 = cuatro 4th = cuarto
 - 5 = cinco 5th = quinto
 - 6 = seis 6th = sexto
 - 7 = siete 7th = septimo
 - 8 = ocho 8th = octavo
 - 9 = nueve 9th = noveno
 - 10=diez 10th = decimo
 - More than 10 = muchas

Pronunciation Tips:

- The letter ‘h’ is always silent in Spanish.
- The letter ‘ll’ is pronounced yaa (as in “yet”).
- The letter ‘ñ’ is pronounced nyaa (as in “canyon”).
- The letter ‘v’ is pronounced bay, like b.

Typing in Spanish:

- ñ = Alt + 0191
- ï = Alt + 0161
- ñ = Alt + 0241
- accents = Ctrl + ‘ and then the letter
- é = Ctrl + ‘ then e
